Corteva Agriscience, in collaboration with National 4-H Council and Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever, has established the Corteva Grows Pollinator Habitat program. This unique program supports the monarch


This unique program supports the monarch butterfly and pollinator habitat at approximately 50 Corteva locations across the country.

The majority of habitat locations reside along the monarch butterfly flyway, the Interstate 35 corridor between Minnesota and Texas. At each location, Corteva provides land and financial support for the pollinator habitat. Site planning kicked off in spring 2019 and will continue through 2020. Each habitat is planted and maintained by the site's employees and 4–H youth leaders. Additionally, Pheasants Forever provides expertise and support, such as habitat seed, site preparation, planting support and ongoing mowing.

Through this joint initiative, more than 30,000 4–H youth are helping increase pollinator populations. With the tools and support needed to understand the importance of pollinators, they're also learning how to build a habitat in their own communities, proactively working toward increasing biodiversity.

These sustainability efforts reflect the commitment of Corteva, National 4-H Council and Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever

to ensure pollinators have access to an adequate habitat and plentiful food sources.
